#### **School uniform expectations:**

Red sweatshirt or cardigan

White polo shirt, shirt or blouse

Grey skirt, trousers or shorts

Black school shoes – suitable and safe for running

Optional:

Red and white checked summer dress (in the warmer months)

### PE expectations:

Plain red or white T-shirt (no large logos or football logos)

Plain black shorts, leggings or track suit bottoms

PE pumps or trainers

Kit to be kept in school in a named PE bag
